Eligibility for Diploma Admission:

For admission to First Semester

Student should have passed SSC/ 10th Std. with English, Science and mathematics with at least 50 % marks for open category and 45 % marks for reserved category.

For admission to Direct Second year

Student should have passed HSC/ 12th Std. with Science English and Specified Technical Subject of 100/200 marks (with at least 50 % marks for open category and 45 % marks for reserve category)

OR

Student should have passed MCVC/ ITI/ NCTVT with Technical Subject as per rules.

Admission Procedure:

There are two types of admission procedures

1) CAP Admission (Centralized Admission Procedure)

In CAP admission procedure, the government allot institute to the student as per merit. Seats in this admission process are 29% of Intake.

2) Institute Level Admission & Minority admission

In this process student can directly approach to the institute for admission. Seats in this admission process are 20% of intake for Institute level & 51% of intake for minority admissions.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST category must fill in the proforma which will be available in the information brochure and it has to be attested by competent authority. These documents should be produced at the time of counseling, failing which they will not be considered for admission.
